He is a source of inspiration, hope and

perseverance for so many. A standout high school football player, LeGrand went on to play for Rutgers University. On October 16, 2010, LeGrand sustained a spinal cord injury at his C3 and C4 vértebrae during a game at MetLife Stadium. While the initial prognosis was grim, Eric demonstrated his titan strength by shattering all expectations for his recovery



and rehabilitation. However recovery was not enough.

Eric has harnessed the national spotlight he attracted from his injury to give back to the community and inspire those living with and impacted by paralysis to bELieve.

From becoming an author, to a much sought after motivational speaker, Eric has given a voice to the paralysis community to mobilize support for critical initiatives, policies and cutting edge research.

Eric was honored in September 2013 with the first number (52) retired in Rutgers 144-year football history. In May 2014, Eric graduated from Rutgers University where he was an honored speaker at the commencement ceremony. He has been recognized by Sports Illustrated with "The Best Moment of 2011" and received the Jimmy V Award for Perseverance at the ESPY Awards.

He has shown the world that obstacles can be transformed into opportunities. To Eric, it is not a matter of if he walks again, but rather, when.
